

His Life

- •354 Is born at Thagaste, on Nov I3
- •371 Goes to study rhetoric in Carthage
- •376 Begins teaching rhetoric in Carthage
- •386 after many letters written from his mother Augustine is converted,
- •387 Returns to Milan, is baptized by Ambrose; at Ostia, he and Monica have "vision," Monica dies there
- •391 Is ordained priest at Hippo
- •392 Writes to Jerome requesting Latin translations of Bible commentaries
- •396 He becomes bishop of Hippo
- •c. 400 Writes his Confessions
- •413-426 Writes The City of God, On the Trinity, and The Enchiridion
- •427 Writes his Retractions
- •430 Dies at Hippo, Aug 28
- •356 St. Anthony an early ascetic born 106 years earlier, dies
