"Marigolds" Jesús Palma


I'm the water you stepped in,



O te quemarás?


Ya no importa más, al paracer Nunca fuiste un gran placer En tener Ya no queda más de tí






"Anxiety Poem" Anonymous

While I cut myself from cleaning all the mess


Am I just a picture on a leather sleeve?


