

Dear Panthers Supporters,

2021-22 was a special year for me in the role of College Counselor here at SJPII because it was the first graduating class that I have watched all the way from their first day here as freshmen to their final walk through the courtyard on their last day as seniors. In spite of what the world threw at them for over half of high school amid a pandemic, they persevered. 50% of our graduates earned a Bright Futures scholarship from the State of Florida for their gpa, their test scores and their community service. As a school, we had a 71% AP (Advanced Placement) pass rate, earning our students college credits and saving future college tuition dollars. We had 5!! seniors accepted into FSU's highly selective CARE Program designed to support Pell Grant Eligible students who are also first generation college students and 1 senior accepted into a similar program at UF (the Promise Program). Both programs are designed to provide additional support to increase retention and graduation rates among first generation college students. Another senior was selected into the elite Questbridge program which matches low-income, high achieving students with highly selective colleges/universities and covers all expenses. (over \$200,000 value). As I read through their college essays last fall in which they revealed even more challenges they had surmounted, I was even more impressed. 100% of the class graduated and were accepted to college even though college admissions is the most competitive it has ever been. We had multiple student-athletes commit to playing their sport while pursuing a college education and many seniors will be the first in their family to go to college. Adolescence is a challenging time for anyone, but we, as a faculty and staff, bore witness to this special class as they struggled, adapted, pivoted and dug deeper; ultimately, they emerged as better human beings in terms of mind, body and spirit. It is an honor to serve our students on their journey of becoming. I feel confident they leave SJPIICHS stronger than when they entered and more confident in their calling as Christians and human beings.







### INCOME VS. EXPENSES




